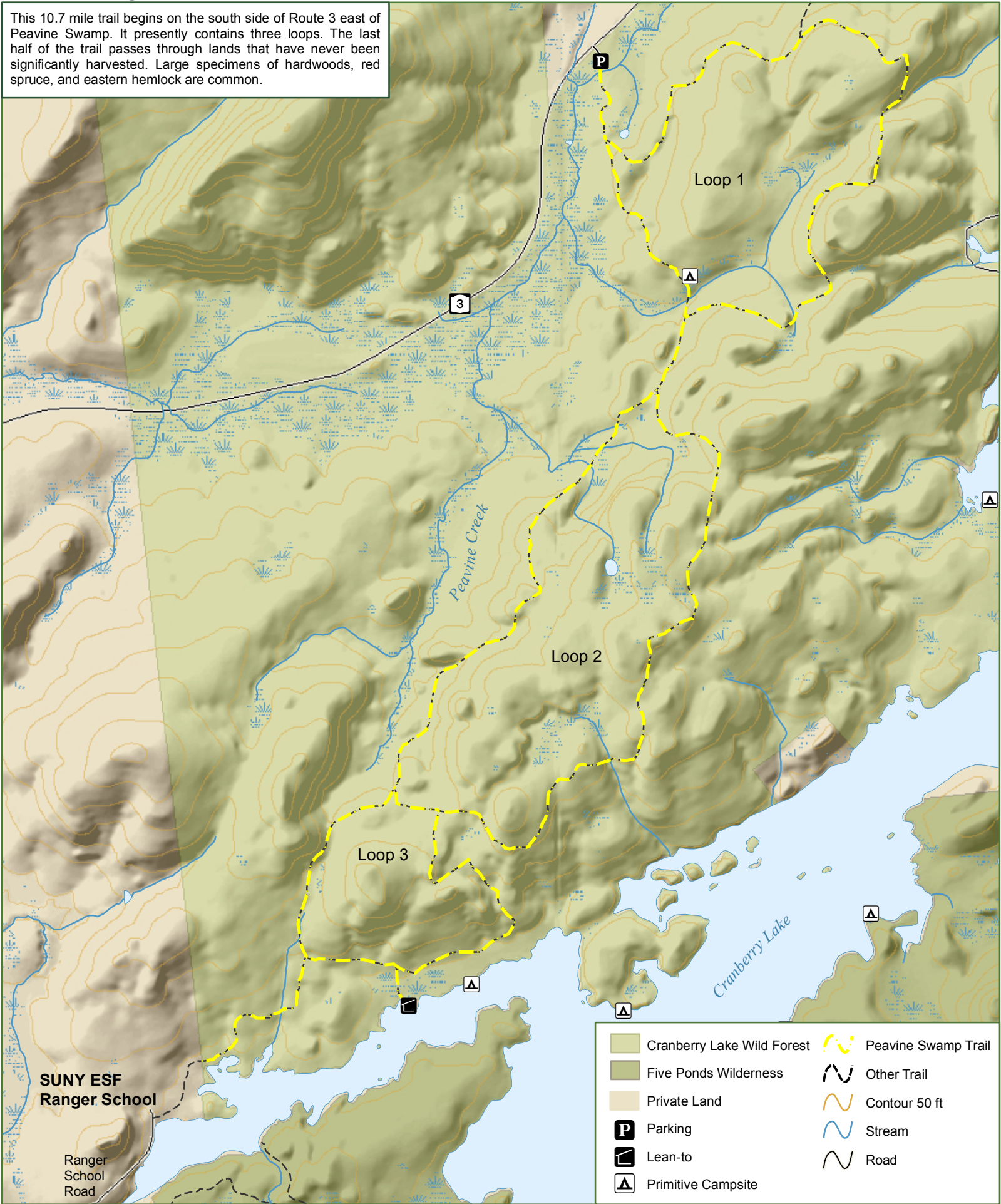


Cranberry Lake Wild Forest - Peavine Swamp Trail

This 10.7 mile trail begins on the south side of Route 3 east of Peavine Swamp. It presently contains three loops. The last half of the trail passes through lands that have never been significantly harvested. Large specimens of hardwoods, red spruce, and eastern hemlock are common.
